

Odcombe


Odcombe village has a population of 759 as per 2011 census figures and is three miles West of Yeovil Town Centre.

The upper part of the village sits on the crest of the hill, while the lower part is built on its northern slopes.

Odcombe Church is located in the centre of the village, built on the highest point in the area, some 100 metres above sea level, on the same ridge as, and close to the Ham Hill Country Park.


The play area has been recently refurbished by the Parish Council.

Plan of Odcombe


